2017-18 Annual Dues

The mandatory dues for the coming year are:

Bloomfield Township homes: \$175 West Bloomfield Township homes: \$360

Dues are due by January 15, 2018

DUES ARE MANDATORY!

Please make note of the following:

- 1. The difference in the amount of dues between the two sides of the subdivision is attributable to the fact that Bloomfield Township residents pay for snow plowing as part of their taxes, and the Wabeek South Homeowners Association must privately contract for these services on the West Bloomfield Township side of the subdivision.
- 2. The payment of dues is not optional. The Wabeek South Homeowners Association is legally authorized to assess and collect these dues. Failure to pay dues in a timely manner will result in a lien being placed on your home and with you being responsible for all associated legal fees and costs. If you are behind on your dues please settle your balance ASAP to avoid a lien by Contacting Dan Steffy (desteffy@gmail.com)
- 3. Please note that the Board has not increased the homeowner's dues this year. We have worked hard to negotiate competitive prices for landscaping and snow removal. We encourage homeowners to attend our meeting and consider volunteering to join the board.

Landscaping and Entrance Lighting

We have improved our Landscaping, removed dead trees and added new LED lights at both Middlebelt and Long Lake entrances. We hope you like the new surroundings.

Street Lights

This Board has investigated the installation of streetlights throughout the subdivision (all streets). Stefanie Madany has been our "lead" representative working with DTE on this project. Many hours have been dedicated to this study. We will provide an update at the November 1, 2017 Annual Meeting. Each year this is suggested and discussed during the Annual Meeting. Please attend to get all the information. The project proposal is not finalized and we need AND want your input. We will need volunteers if we proceed.

Cul-de-sac renovations

Wabeek South has many cul-de-sacs, some of which contain beautiful plantings, but many of which are undecorated. The board has started program by which the HOA will split the cost of landscaping individual cul-de-sacs with the adjacent homeowners. Homeowners would select plantings according to their own taste and the HOA would contribute 50% of the cost (up to a maximum of \$2000 contribution per cul-de-sac) and offer future maintenance. Such improvements beautify the neighborhood and raise property values for all. Interested homeowners should contact the board for more information.



Road Condition Update

WEST BLOOMFIELD SIDE

Roads throughout the West Bloomfield side of Wabeek South were replaced in 2000 by the Road Commission of Oakland County (RCOC). A 15-year warranty was attached to this project and over the past year some final under-warranty repairs were made. Moving forward, the RCOC is still responsible for maintaining our roads but, with the expiration of the warranty, will only fill potholes using "cold patch" asphalt. Cracks will also be filled with sealant. Residents are encouraged to report potholes and cracks on the West Bloomfield side to the RCOC by calling (877) 858-4804. Prompt repair of small cracks and potholes can help to prevent more serious deterioration in the future.

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP SIDE

The project of repaving the roads in the special assessment district was completed late 2014. Residents can enjoy safer driving conditions and increased property values. Maintenance is the responsibility of the Bloomfield Township Road Division. Residents should contact the Bloomfield Township Road Division at (248) 594–2800 to request repairs.

Around the Neighborhood

With the sun setting earlier this time of year the neighborhood can become very dark in the evening. We encourage homeowners to help illuminate our neighborhood using porch lights or landscaping lights in the evening.

- Appropriately trim shrubs around your home

- Cars parked outside of a garage should not contain visible goods in the cabin that could be the target of theft
